Recommended usage rates:

#### **In Wet Process of Fur-Suede;**

Wetting	0,5 – 1,0 g/L
1. washing	2,0 – 3,0 g/L
2. washing	2,0 – 3,0 g/L

#### **In Degreasing Process;**

Native Sheepskin	3,0 – 5,0 % over pelt weight
Native Lambskin	1,5 – 2,5 % over pelt weight
New Zeland pickle	4,0 – 7,0 % over pickle weight
Avustralian Merino	4,0 – 7,0 %
English	4,0 – 6,0 %

### STORAGE :

In a cool and dry place in original packaging, can be stored for a period of one year. Product must be protected from excessive heat and cold.
